6.2 Subdivision Application 4202-18-8031 - Williamson SE36-09-20W Councillor Foerster - Councillor Storey

Whereas 733225 Manitoba Ltd. (Doug & Denise Williamson) Registered owners of SE36-09-20W (130 acres) made an application for subdivision.

And Whereas The intent of the application is to create twenty (20) rural residential 2 acres parcels along the eastern edge of the half section. The proposed lots are to be serviced by septic fields with water provided from a piped water extension. Each lot will have access to a new municipal road that will run through the centre of the proposed subdivision. The proposed public road will have two (2) access points from separate government road allowances. There are two public reserves in the proposed plan for drainage.

And Whereas the subdivision application with revised drawings indicates a new public road and public lane proposed, notice of the Public Hearing held this day as required under the provisions of the Planning Act was given in accordance with Section 169 of same.

And Whereas Resolution No. 7 dated July 13, 2020 to repealed as per Community Planning and that this application is to be considered as new from date received September 11, 2023.

Now therefore be it resolved that subdivision File No. 4202-18-8031 be approved with the following conditions:

- 1. That a Development Agreement be entered into between the Rural Municipality of Whitehead and the proponents, and to be prepared by the municipal solicitor at the sole cost of the developer/proponent and registered on all 20 lots (titles).
- 2. That an Engineered Drainage Plan as outlined by the Province of Manitoba, Environment Climate & Parks be approved by Council ahead of any works commencing and paid by the developer/proponent.
- 3. That an Engineered Rural Waterline infrastructure plan be constructed at the Developers/Proponents cost and submitted prior to any works commencing.
- 4. That engineered specifications and construction standards are followed for the proposed public road.
- 5. That ALL residences shall be connected to the RM of Whitehead rural water pipeline system at the sole cost to the developer/proponent. Cost for same shall be in accordance with the current Utility Connection Policy and to be paid prior to any work commencing.
- 6. That a Zoning By-law Amendment be approved changing the zoned area from RR5 to RR2. Cost for same to be determined by the Annual Schedule of Fees By-law that is active at the time of application and to be paid by the developer/proponent.
- 7. That a financial levy of \$10,000.00 (\$500.00 X 20 lots) be made to the Rural Municipality of Whitehead Fire Capital Reserve Fund, By-law No. 2111.
- That a subdivision application administration fee in the amount of \$5,000.00 (\$250.00 x 20 lots) be paid as per the Annual Schedule of Fees By-law.
- 9. That an application fee for the development of access road be paid in accordance with the Annual Schedule of Fees By-law.

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10. That separate variance applications be approved for each of the following lots to
vary the site width from the minimum requirements of 200: Lot 4 down to 146
ft, lot 11 down to 71.15 feet, lot 12 down to 187 ft, lot 17 down to 183 feet.

- 11. That any survey monuments that are required to be added or restored be at the sole cost of the developer/proponent.
- 12. That the developer/proponent, at their expense, be responsible for any street lighting that may be required. **CARRIED**
